BEHAVIOR RULES FOR SAUK COUNTY EXHIBITORS

Notice: No overnight supervision of lodging, facilities are available for minors attending the Sauk County Fair.

1. No one will be allowed to smoke in any of the Junior Exhibit Buildings -- including barns.
2. No one will be allowed to consume alcoholic beverages or other intoxicating substances in any of the Junior Exhibit Areas including buildings and barns at any time.
3. The Junior Exhibit Buildings (including barns) will be closed to the public between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
4. Anyone who is intoxicated or exhibits "rowdy" behavior will not be allowed in the Junior Exhibit area.
5. When violations of the above conditions occur, all violators will:
 - a. be asked to cease the activity and leave the fairgrounds (parents will be called day or night)
 - b. forfeit all premiums for the current fair and immediately remove all of his or her exhibits.
 - c. forfeit the opportunity to be a Junior Exhibitor to the State Fair.

BEHAVIOR RULES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The Sauk County Fair discourages the practice of minors spending the night at the Fairgrounds. Adult supervision of minors is not provided at the Sauk County Fair during nighttime hours.

I and my children are aware of the rules governing Junior Exhibitor's behavior. I realize that the Sauk county UWEX Staff, Vo-Ag Instructors, Fair Board or their representatives are not responsible for the safety and conduct of my child. Furthermore, I will remove my child from the grounds, if requested, by a Fair official day or night.

Entry is not valid unless signed by a parent or legal guardian and exhibitor and submitted at time the Fair entry is made.
