What's the reason for all these fees? The answer is simple. Waste disposal and recycling. It will cost the Fair Board in excess of \$1500. to dispose of waste from the Sauk County Barns. The cost of waste disposal could be reduced somewhat if barn waste is kept clean of plastic cups, aluminum cans, paper and all other non-animal waste. The Fair Board recognizes that exhibitors are not necessarily responsible for this extra trash in the manure pits. However, exhibitors, leaders and parents do need to assume some responsibility for policing those areas and keeping them free of non-animal waste. Otherwise, it may be necessary to raise the fees in the future. While the Fair Board intends to have other containers in which fair-goers can dispose of their trash. They need the exhibitors, leaders and parents to help out as well. Waste disposal is an issue that affects everyone.
